### **Judging Criteria:**

Building Skill – Building skill demonstrated (based on entrant's age), Creativity and Originality

Interpretation of the Theme – How well does it represent **VOYAGEURS?**

All voting will be done by viewer's choice on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2017 as a part of the Canada Day Celebration. Prizes will be awarded on July 2<sup>nd</sup> 2017 to all winners.

### **BUILDING CONTEST RULES:**

Use your own LEGO® bricks and elements to build an original creation at home. Then bring your completed creation to the Rocky Mountain House National Historic Site for display and judging.

Use only genuine LEGO® bricks, elements, and pieces. Non-Lego embellishments may be added but the build must be made from LEGO®. Constructions made from specialty themed LEGO® kits are not eligible and will be disqualified, although elements from specialty kits may be used in original designs.

Designs **must be** original.

Only ONE creation per person (a family counts as one person) may be entered.

Your creation **must** be no taller than 4 ft.

Entries must be delivered in person to the Rocky Mountain House National Historic Site, between the hours of 10am and 5pm on or before Monday June 26<sup>th</sup> 2017.

Entries must be brought ready to be displayed, secured with no loose parts. Construction will not be permitted on site.

All entries must be accompanied by a fully completed entry form. You may complete your form when you drop off. Alternatively, forms are available at the Historic Site commencing May 10<sup>th</sup>, or you can contact 403-845-6680 and request an email copy, or download from the web: <http://www.confluencehs.ca/canada-day.htm>.

Public viewing and judging will begin at 10 am. The winners will be announced and contacted no earlier than 2pm Sunday July 2, 2017. Contest entries **MUST** be removed from Rocky Mountain House National Historic Site by the following Friday July 7<sup>th</sup> 2017 during the hours of 10am-5pm.

**PRIZES:** Prizes will be award in each age category. There are also Mayor's choice awards to be assigned.
